The content focuses on the development of knowledge, related to global citizenship issues and the improvement of skills like global vision, critical thinking, cooperative work, ways of organisation and methods for planning, decision making, participation and activism, through training sessions.

The handbook is accompanied by hands-on activities facilitated by gamified learning techniques that can engage users into the learning process either this occurs remotely or within a classroom environment.

What are we teaching?
